

The UN FOOD SYSTEMS SUMMIT 2021 Guiding Notes for Benin National Dialogue

The following are suggested guiding notes for consideration in the preparation of the Benin National consultations:

- 1. Ministry of Agriculture to guide on arrangements and participation in National dialogue
- 2. Constitute the focal institutions/person(s) to organize the Malawi consultation meeting and to prepare a synthesis: Possibly Agricultural Research and Extension Trust, RUFORUM and Ministry of Agriculture and Food Security focal person to coordinate the arrangements. Dr Sylvanus Mensah is the contact person for RUFORUM and can be contacted at RUFORUM Secretariat (secretariat@ruforum.org with copy to s.mensah@ruforum.org))
- 3. Identify the key questions that should be addressed
- 4. Reach out to various institutions and agencies at national level for the dialogue: the stakeholders should include, among others, Ministry of Agriculture officials, other Government Ministries, farmers' institutions, research systems, Agricultural Research Organisation in Benin, universities, youths, NGOs, Private sector, etc.
- 5. Choose the date (s); we propose 7th June 2021 so as to allow inputs from the National Consultation to guide the presentation by the Minister of Agriculture and Food Security during the Advocates for Africa's development meeting on 17th June 2021.
- 6. Identify the key voices, the speakers, including the moderator
- 7. Participate/Contribute to the drafting of the Benin Government Statement to UN Food Systems Summit
- 8. Prepare meeting report of current situation, key drivers and issues, needed actions and by whom; what should be the key messages from the dialogue for consideration by the Benin Government for action at National level, AUC and presentation at the UN Summit
- 9. Organize zoom convening (RUFORUM Secretariat can assist in this)



- 10. Advertise widely the consultation and the zoom meeting
- 11. Register the event in the UN FSS platform
