## 14th RUFORUM Principals and Deans Open Meeting

#### **Concept Note**

#### **Background**

The Regional Universities Forum for Capacity Building in Agriculture (RUFORUM) is network of 66 universities in 26 African countries. RUFORUM mission is to strengthen the capacities of African Universities to foster innovations responsive to demands of small-holder farmers through the training of high quality researchers, the output of impact oriented research, and the maintenance of collaborative working relations among researchers, farmers and national agricultural research institutions. The Universities recognise the rapidly evolving Africa's higher education and thus are committed to partner with other actors to deliver quality, affordable and relevant education in the continent.

The refreshed Strategic Business Plan 2015-2020 and the mid-term review undertaken in April 2017 recognise the importance of all three traditional mandates of the universities – namely training, research, and outreach and increasing policy advocacy. There is to also a now call on the universities to strengthen Vocationalisation as a mechanism to train market and industry ready graduates as well as entrepreneurial graduates to engage in enterprise development. These recognitions come at the backdrop of a youthful population boom in Africa whose needs for jobs and good quality life in the 21<sup>st</sup> century must be squarely addressed. Universities have been recognised as well placed to strategically respond to these needs.

The Principals and Deans are heads of academic programmes in RUFORUM member universities and, as such, play a pivotal role in shaping the strategic direction of the Organisation and are responsible for ensuring delivery of quality educational programmes. They are responsible for monitoring the skill requirements for the evolving market and to steer readjustments in training focus and delivery. Accordingly, the Principals and Deans form one of the Board Committees that is central to RUFORUM's operations. During the 13<sup>th</sup> Principals and Deans meeting held in October 2016 in Cape Town, South



Africa, it was highlighted that RUFORUM universities are required to: i) produce more relevant and user oriented research; ii) train proactive and skilled graduates; iii) promote institutionalization of enabling policies, principles and practices; and iv) mainstream new approaches in pedagogy and academic management. Accordingly, during the same meeting, the Principals and Deans deliberated on the need for transformative curriculum development and leadership in higher agricultural education in Africa. These aspirations are part of the wider RUFORUM universities commitment to a transformative higher education sector in the continent for development relevance.
