## Background

The Regional Universities Forum for Capacity Building in Agriculture (RUFORUM) is currently implementing its Agricultural Higher Education, Science Technology and Innovation (AHESTI) strategy (Vision 2030) strategy. This is based on four flagship areas: i) Transforming African Agricultural Universities to meaningfully contribute to Africa's growth and development (TAGDev); ii) Partnership of Anchor Universities Developing Agriculture (PAUDA); iii) Cultivating Research and Teaching Excellence (CREATE); and iv) Knowledge Hub for University Networking, Partnerships and Advocacy (K-Hub).
