

Conclusions

- The number of engagements on Facebook was twice the number of engagements on Twitter
- On average the same number of people were reached on Facebook and Twitter
- Twitter performed better than Facebook posts in terms of shares with an average of 3
 shares per post while Facebook had less than 1 share per post on average
- The #PreUNFoodSummit 2021 drew engagement to the posts on Twitter with 23 hashtag clicks in total
